

Coordinated by International Arctic Science Committee (IASC) i cooperation with 26 international organisations


Community-wide undertaking from **2022 to 2026** that engages Arctic researchers, Indigenous Peoples, policy makers, residents and stakeholders from around the world to:

- Develop **recommendations to implement** these priorities








### **ICARP IV Reporting and Implementation**
